

# BRULE ROAD QUARRY

Lat 44° 17' N Long 76° 39' W



**DIRECTIONS:** Brule Road lies about 3.5 Km West of the Collins Bay Road / Princess St (Hwy 2) junction. The Quarry is towards the North end of Brule Road, on the right hand side.

Divers should expect to pay a small fee for entry - \$5 in 2010.

**ATTRACTIONS:** The Quarry offers a variety of underwater objects for divers to visit. A large sunken cabin cruiser is present in the deepest section (about 28') and old car hulks are nearby. Several old Bass Boats and other objects are easily found. In the Summer months, many fish (Bluegills, Bass and their fry) abound.

**FACILITIES:** There are basic toilet facilities, but no formal changing area and no refreshments available on site.

**VISIBILITY:** Variable. Undisturbed, particularly in the Winter months, in excess of 60'. Expect to find many swimmers and paddlers during Summer months
